



### Ideas on how to use the Human Values Tree

- To introduce visitors to the school to the values and give them the opportunity to pledge their support
- To display the value for the week e.g. Patience – good examples of patience can be acknowledged by hanging a leaf with a description and a pear for peace
- To acknowledge good behaviour and special effort e.g. honesty, courage, determination
- To celebrate acts of kindness and helpfulness e.g. hang a leaf for a kindness you would like to show appreciation of
- To celebrate whole class achievements e.g. the tidiest class hangs a leaf describing their efforts with cherries for right conduct
- To acknowledge parents contributions and involvement e.g. a child, or the school may wish to say a special thank you, and also for parents to do the same
- To remember those who are sick or suffering
- To give love an encouragement to anyone who is experiencing difficulties in school or at home
- To give encouragement to good intentions e.g. Class 1 are working hard to improve their spellings
- To draw attention to examples of good values in the community or news
- To raise awareness of the values amongst the whole school staff and governors by inviting them to contribute too
