Training in the SSEHV Diploma Course 1 will be held in Pinner, Middlesex on the following days: Friday 2nd April Session 1, Saturday 3rd April Session 2, Sunday 4th April Session 3, Monday 5th April Session 4, Tuesday 6th April Session 5, Wednesday 7th April Session 6, Thursday 8th April Session 7, Friday 9th April Session 8.

The course will explain the principles in detail and give you the practical skills needed to start teaching Sathya Sai EHV as part of PSHE, RE, Assembly or Citizenship classes, either as a teacher or as a volunteer support assistant in your local school. Also, many participants say they find it an excellent training in Life Skills for themselves.

A minimum of ten participants is required for the course to go ahead and we ask people to commit to attend all sessions. Preference will be given to those who are willing to offer voluntary support to the SSEHV programme. Full information on Open College Network accreditation and the work it involves will be given during the course.
